- Active, unrestricted California-licensed clinician registered and in good standing with the BBS. A copy of the license must be provided to Evergreen Counseling. Associates welcome.



- Available to maintain a caseload of 24 - 26 patients provided such sessions are available and referred/scheduled by Evergreen Counseling.
- Must be able and willing to work the following days and times: Mondays - 8am - 5pm; Tuesdays - 5- 9pm; Wednesdays 5-9pm; Thursdays - 8am - 5pm
- Must be willing and able to start this position on either September 15 or October 1.

Job Duties and Responsibilities:



1. Perform on-site clinical counseling services to patients of Evergreen Counseling, as scheduled, and in accordance with company policies.
2. Regular and reliable attendance and timely arrival to work is required.
3. Be properly licensed and abide by all laws, rules, regulations, and codes of ethics that are binding upon or applicable to the services performed for Evergreen Counseling.
4. Respond to patients' requests for service or calls within 24 hours whether such requests are made in person, by phone, voicemail, or by email. Respond to such requests by meeting, evaluating, and providing services to such patients.
5. Communicate with a patient's treatment team (i.e., PCP, psychiatrist, school, etc.) as necessary.
6. Timely complete written records for each patient including, but not limited to: intake notes, progress notes, treatment plans, termination notes, contract notes, and other forms or documents which may be needed or required from time-to-time by Evergreen Counseling or third parties in conjunction with the treatment of the patient within a timely fashion (by Friday of each week). Maintain accurate and up-to-date calendars and client information using practice management software (SimplePractice).
7. Charge and collect payments from patients for services provided consistent with the policy and rate for such services as established by Evergreen Counseling.
8. Attend mandatory staff meetings and training as directed by Evergreen Counseling.
9. Conduct and regulate counseling services in a professional manner so as to maintain and increase the goodwill and reputation of Evergreen Counseling. Be respectful of and cooperative and collaborative with co-workers.
10. Additional opportunities available if desired (but not required) – starting a group, teaching a class, giving presentations, etc..
11. Other duties which may be assigned by Evergreen Counseling.
